
Applications are accepted now through May 31 for students impacted by a brain tumor diagnosis.

This project hopes to identify qualitative vs. quantitative discussions between patient and health care providers.

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
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
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BRAIN TUMOR AWARENESS MONTH

SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

VOICES OF HOPE SCHOLARSHIP

The SBTF Voices of Hope Scholarship application for the 2023/2024 Academic Year is now available! We know the financial impact of medical treatment and hope to provide the courage for students to pursue their dreams by offering scholarship funds.

Eligibility: The applicant must have been directly impacted by their brain tumor diagnosis or the diagnosis of another individual. Must be a legal resident of the United States and enrolled in an accredited United States post-secondary educational program. Please see the Official Rules for further details.

Application Deadline: The application must be received by 11:59 pm EST on May 31, 2023.

Award Distribution: The scholarship award amount shall be no less than \$1,500. Scholarship award recipients for the 2023/2024 Academic year will be notified by the end of June 2023. Award monies will be disbursed directly to the scholarship recipient's educational institution for the 2023/2024 academic year.

Scholarship Highlights: SBTF has awarded a total of 49 Scholarships totaling the amount of \$102,000 since the program's inception in 2019.
