





- Founded in 1995, the SBTF is a 501c(3) not-for-profit public charity based in the metro-Atlanta area supporting the brain tumor community nationwide.
- SBTF has funded over \$3,060,000 in research grants.
- SBTF hosts six monthly support groups for patients and caregivers facilitated by medical professionals.
- SBTF has awarded over \$260,000 in educational scholarships to 110 students impacted by a brain tumor diagnosis.
- During treatment, the SBTF provides patient care bags and programs to assist with transportation to appointments, grocery delivery, and meal assistance.
- SBTF partners with other brain tumor organizations to achieve our mission.

At Southeastern Brain Tumor Foundation, our primary mission is to improve the quality of life for brain tumor patients and their families. By working together with our supporters, we aim to continue to be a source of hope through counseling, education and support.
